- ▶ Survey and interview data storage initiated (May 2017) - put on hold Sept 2017 due to Irma hurricane response. Will be continued later,
- ▶ PM recruitment and familiarisation with ESUPS and Steering Group members expectations,
- ▶ ESUPS website design and compilation of content,
- ▶ Concept Note ToR of ESUPS Steering Committee developed and approved,
- ▶ Key elements of ESUPS strategy identified:
 - ▶ Asia as pilot region
 - ▶ Natural disasters only
 - ▶ Response frame of 6-8 weeks
 - ▶ Two simultaneous emergencies
 - ▶ List of (11) relief items determined
- ▶ Models and matrix develop by MIT.
